
SNAP E BIKE @ RENTALS

South to Horseshoe Falls & Chippawa on the Niagara Parkway & Recreational Trail

Round Trip is 20 KM

- 1 Snap E-Bike (Ride in the bike lane for 2 km. At the Rainbow Bridge, ride on the parkway side-by-side, until reaching Point of Interest #5)
- Queen Victoria Park (To access the Falls, park in front of the Niagara Parks Police Station and use the Crosswalk)
- Nikola Tesla Statue (Hard to access with the bikes, but easy to see as you drive by)
- Floral Showhouse (Enter the grounds after passing Canadian Niagara Power Plant)
- International Niagara Control Works (Re-enter the trail)
- Kingsbridge Park (Picnic & Views of the Hydro Electric Dams)
- Ride the Boardwalk Across the Welland River (Turn around or continue towards Fort Erie)
- Dufferin Islands Nature Area (Man-made park on a one-way street)
- 1918 Scow Barge (View this shipwreck from the South-side of the former Toronto Hydro Power Station)





- Horseshoe Falls Viewpoint (Enter at the bus station. No left-turns so access this spot while riding North.)
- Whirlpool Aero Car (Add 5 km to your trip for the worthwhile lookout point)

- Snap E-Bike Rentals
- Ginkgo Biloba Tree (A very old species, with some fossils dating back 270 million years. The leaves have medicinal properties. Pick a few to eat and try for yourself.)
- Former Customs Building & Post Office (Built in 1883 of Limestone in the Romanesque Revival Style)
- Decommissioned Railroad Bridge, (Walk along this former Railroad for Amazing Views of the River)
- 5 Water Molecule Statue (Downtown Park)
- Daredevil Alley (Tribute to those who Conquered the Falls)
- Train Station (Constructed in 1879 in Victorian Gothic Revival Style)
